**Content:**

Quercus TFI S.A communicates, that according to the notification received today from Buczek S.K.A. with registered seat in Warsaw (previously Eagle 3 spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością spółka komandytowo-akcyjna with registered seat in Warsaw – entity dependent on Mr. Sebastian Buczek within the meaning of the Act) on decreasing by Buczek S.K.A. with registered seat in Warsaw the share in the total number of votes in Quercus TFI S.A. and going below the level of 5% of the total number of votes of the Issuer.

Going below the level of 5% of the total number of votes in the Company took place as a result of the transfer of 5.900.000 shares of the Issuer as a part of payment for the investment certificates of the close end investment fund in the form of the above mentioned shares on 23 May 2013.

Before the change of the share, Buczek S.K.A. with registered seat in Warsaw held 5.900.000 shares of the Issuer, which constituted 8.30% of the share capital. Held shares gave 5.900.000 votes at the General Meeting of the Issuer, which constituted 8.30% of the total number of votes at the General Meeting.

On 29 May 2013, Buczek S.K.A. does not hold any shares of the Issuer.

There are no persons which are stipulated in the article 87 section 1 item 3 point c of the Act.
